Subject: 2013 Erosion Survey Reports.

Dear Mr. Christie:

We received your survey reports for erosion conditions for the Sanford, Edenville, Secord, and Smallwood Projects, filed April 4, 2014, pursuant to the Order Approving Erosion Control Plans, issued April 26, 1999.<sup>1</sup> The filed reports summarize your surveys of the erosion conditions found around the reservoirs and along the tailtraces of the above projects.

You state in the reports that for all four projects' land, the condition of the banks has not changed significantly since your last reports. The reports include the inventories and classifications of all the monitored sites along the shoreline and their GPS locations.

In the filing you did not indicate the reports were filed with the resource agencies prior to filing them with the Commission. However, in response to a phone conversation with staff, on May 21st, 2014, you supplemented the filing with documentation of submittal of the reports to the Michigan Department of Natural Resources and the US Fish and Wildlife Service. You state that if the Resource Agencies provide any

comments on these submitted reports, you will include such in a resubmission of said reports after a 30 day period.

We remind you that future reports should be provided to the resource agencies at least 30 days prior to filing them with the Commission. Further, the reports you file with the Commission should include documentation that the reports were provided to the resource agencies and include any agency comments and your response to the agencies' comments.
