Dear Congressman Moolenaar:

Thank you for your letter dated April 11, 2018, concerning Boyce Hydro Power's Edenville Hydroelectric Project No. 10808 located on the Tittabawassee and Tobacco Rivers in Gladwin and Midland counties, Michigan. In an order issued February 15, 2018, the Commission proposed revoking Boyce Hydro Power's license for this project because of longstanding failures to comply with its license.

In your letter, you support a recent request from the Wixom and Sanford Lake Associations to delay any decision to revoke the license. You say these lake associations, county governments, and other stakeholders have begun working together to determine whether someone else can own the dam and address the non-compliance issues.

The proposed revocation proceeding is pending before the Commission and is subject to the Commission's ex-parte rules. Therefore, I cannot comment on your April 11, 2018, letter. However, I have placed your comments and this response in the record of this proceeding. If I can be of any further assistance in this or any other Commission matter, please let me know.
