
Dear Ms. Bose:

Wixom Lake Association has reviewed the Commission's *Order Proposing Revocation of License* dated February 15, 2018 for the Edenville, Michigan hydroelectric project (P-10808).

Wixom Lake Association is a 501(c)(3) corporation and the only organization that speaks on behalf of several thousand members of the public who either have waterfront property on or otherwise make use of Wixom Lake, the impoundment created by P-10808. We have a strong interest in preserving the lake for public use. The proposed revocation of license raises the possibility that regulatory authority over the Edenville Dam and Wixom Lake could pass from the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission to agencies of the State of Michigan. Should the license be revoked or surrendered, we ask the Commission to perform a smooth and orderly transfer of responsibilities to the State which does not compromise preexisting recreational opportunities, and corrects current recreational and/or access deficiencies.

WLA wishes to preserve the option of having a formal voice in the proposed revocation proceedings, as future public use of Wixom Lake is dependent upon the outcome of those proceedings and subsequent regulatory actions. Therefore, we respectfully ask to intervene in these proceedings.
