License Revocation and Requirement for Electrical Power

Mr. Zygaj:

This letter is written to request FERC's consideration of Boyce Hydro Power, LLC's need to have electric power at its Edenville hydro plant and its offices, shop, and garage buildings nearby after the forced shut down of operations is due to take effect on September 25, 2018. Currently, Boyce's facilities receive electric power generated by the Edenville powerhouse. Boyce's income from the Edenville operation is reduced by the amount of usage.

FERC's recent revocation order directs Boyce to "permanently disable the project's generating equipment" within 15 days of the order and file with FERC the meter reading and a photograph of the meter at the time of shut down. However, it is possible to disconnect the plant from the grid without removing Boyce's ability to receive power from Consumers Energy. The two breakers, shown in the photo, would be removed, and the high voltage knife switches pulled which would prevent electrical generation.



Electric power is needed at the powerhouse to run gates, the computer, heaters, fans, pumps and lights. The office, shops and garages must still have electric power to continue to operate the other three FERC-licensed projects.

Boyce therefore requests FERC acceptance of this method of disabling generation capability at Edenville.
